#### **RISLA Overview:**

The Rhode Island Student Loan Authority (RISLA) is a non-profit, quasi-state agency of the State of Rhode Island which administers a system of financial assistance, consisting of grants, loans, and counseling for college admissions and applying for financial aid. RISLA must compete with large forprofit and other non-profit lenders and operates without any state appropriations. To provide the capital needed to fund student loans, RISLA regularly issues debt and/or secures bank financing which are not backed by the credit of the State of Rhode Island.

# **Position Scope & Responsibilities:**

The Executive Director provides strategic leadership and oversight for all day-to-day operations, ensuring that RISLA achieves its objectives and mission. The Executive Director must work closely with the RISLA Board of Directors, colleges and universities and federal and state officials to ensure that the organization is fulfilling its mission and serving its constituents effectively.
